History

ISACA was incorporated by individuals who recognized a need for a centralized source of information and guidance in the growing field of auditing controls for computer systems. Today, ISACA has more than 95,000 members worldwide.

Overview

ISACA got its start in 1967, when a small group of individuals with similar jobs—auditing controls in the computer systems that were becoming increasingly critical to the operations of their organizations—sat down to discuss the need for a centralized source of information and guidance in the field. In 1969, the group formalized, incorporating as the EDP Auditors Association. In 1976 the association formed an education foundation to undertake large-scale research efforts to expand the knowledge and value of the IT governance and control field. **Previously known as the Information Systems Audit and Control Association**, ISACA now goes by its acronym only, to reflect the broad range of IT governance professionals it serves.

Today, ISACA's membership—more than 95,000 strong worldwide—is characterized by its diversity. Members live and work in more than 160 countries and cover a variety of professional IT-related positions—to name just a few, IS auditor, consultant, educator, IS security professional, regulator, chief information officer and internal auditor. Some are new to the field, others are at middle management levels and still others are in the most senior ranks. They work in nearly all industry categories, including financial and banking, public accounting, government and the public sector, utilities and manufacturing. This diversity enables members to learn from each other, and exchange widely divergent viewpoints on a variety of professional topics. It has long been considered one of ISACA's strengths.

Global Network

Another of ISACA's strengths is its chapter network. ISACA has more than 190 chapters established in over 75 countries worldwide, and those chapters provide members education, resource sharing, advocacy, professional networking and a host of other benefits on a local level. 




Background

In 1980 there was only one chapter of the EDPAA in the state of North Carolina. This chapter was headquartered in Charlotte and drew participation for EDP Auditors as far east as Winston-Salem and Greensboro. EDP Auditors further east were either not associated with the EDPAA or they drove to Virginia to participate with chapters there.

Sometime in the early 1980's, a group of Charlotte members from the Triad area (Greensboro, Winston-Salem, and High Point) decided to split off from the larger chapter and form their own group. The major reason behind the movement was simply to cut down on the travel required to attend chapter meetings. So the Triad Chapter was created sometime in the early 1980's. Not much is known about the activities of the chapter during its existence because the records have been lost. The chapter did struggle with pulling in new members because a lot of auditors did not want to release their ties from the Charlotte chapter. The chapter was able to present a seminar or workshop sometime during their life which provided them with some operating capital.





1985-1986

(Creation) In June of 1985, Stephen Head, outgoing President of the Triad Chapter, contacted Manny Rojas of Central Carolina Bank (CCB) and Jerry Truchinski of Carolina Power & Light (CP&L). Mr. Head informed these gentlemen that the Triad Chapter was dissolving and was looking for someone to save what was left of the chapter. Rojas and Truchinski set up a meeting for Wednesday, June 26, 1985, to meet with Mr. Head in Durham. Also invited to the meeting were Charlie Stainback of Branch Banking & Trust (BB&T), Jim Hinson (CP&L), and Jim Shaw (CCB). In the meeting, Mr. Head explained how nearly all of the Triad Chapter leaders were leaving the area for new jobs. They had issued a call within the Triad Chapter at the last chapter meeting to ask for volunteers to take over the reins. When no one came forward, the decision was made to fold the chapter and submit the treasury to the EDPAA Foundation or to seek others to take over.

The decision was made that these gentlemen would move the Triad Chapter to the Research Triangle area and attempt revitalization. With that, Mr. Head turned over the treasury of \$1,250 to this group along with chapter records and a small inventory of resource books. Thus was born what we know today as the Research Triangle Chapter. The mak=jor duties of the chapter were divided up that day and officer assignments made as follows:

The first meeting was held August 22 at Balentines and featured simply a "welcome to all." President Jerry Truchinski explained the direction of the chapter and appealed for new members. The meeting was well attended (over 30 professionals were in attendance). The meeting did generate a number of new applications for membership, so the chapter started with approximately 25 members on the roll.

The name of the chapter was officially changed in October 1985 by the National Headquarters from Triad to Research Triangle. In the spring, the Raleigh/Durham chapter of the IIA invited us to join with them in a joint meeting in January. This meeting was conducted in coordination ith the IIA's regional meeting which the Raleigh/Durham chapter also hosted. Over 100 people were on hand to hear Admiral Grace Hopper of the US Navy relate stories about the early days of computer processing. This first year, eight chapter meetings were held with an average attendance of approximately 20 people.

In February 1987, the chapter conducted its first two-day seminar featuring five different concurrent sessions using seven guest speakers. With approximately 50 attendees, the seminar was successful and provided the chapter with approximately \$2,000 of operating capital. Out of this, the chapter made its first contribution to the EDP Auditors Foundation (EDPAF) for research.

A variety of technical and non-technical speakers were obtained for the chapter meetings by Teresa. Lester led a membership drive which results in the positive growth for the chapter, increasing the membership list to 49 people. The chapter put together a customized two-day seminar presented personally by Michael Sobol (MIS) in February. Approximately 55 professionals attended the two-day event which netted the chapter approximately \$3,600 in operating income. Sobol was the guest speaker at the chapter meeting held the first night of the seminar which drew in a record attendance for a chapter meeting of 53 people. The meeting even attracted other Region 7 chapter presidents and leaders. The board again made a presentation to the EDPAF.

Considerable movement and turnover of chapter members occurred during the year resulting in a number of people serving on the Board of Directors. This was to be the year of the "New Look" for the Research Triangle Chapter. A summer seminar was sponsored in 1989 by the Research Triangle Chapter free of charge to its members and only a \$50 fee for non-members. Coopers & Lybrand, from Atlanta, came in and presented a "Day of Development and Disaster" which drew approximately 30 attendees, both members and non-members. In February 1990, the second annual Central Carolina Audit and Control Conference was held jointly by the Raleigh-Durham IIA Chapter and the Research Triangle Chapter EDPAA. Teresa Barnes McCauley and Kirk Whorf represented EDPAA in this production.

The EDPAA/EDPAF Chapter Recognition Reward for Medium Chapters was presented to the Research Triangle Chapter for Chapter Year 1989-90.

Once again, a successful joint conference was held with the Raleigh-Durham Chapter IIA. The format was a little different from previous years: the IIA had two tracks the first day and the EDPAA had two tracks on the second day. The conference netted the chapter \$2,600. Again, 10% of the proceeds were donate to the EDPAF. TV news personality Lloyd Dobbins entertained guests at dinner on the first day, speaking on "Quality or Else." The chapter gained 14 new members and ended the year with a total of 55 members. Terry Smith coordinated six pre-meeting technical sessions, all at no charge to the membership. Meetings were advertised in the Raleigh and Durham newspapers. The Secretary sent out confirmations and thank-you letters to each speaker this year. Teresa McCauley and Ben McLawhorn published a professional Directory. Pam Gragg issued the monthly newsletter, which took on a new format.

The Research Triangle Chapter made a monetary contribution to the formation of the Piedmont Triad Chapter in Winston-Salem. The donation was presented to the Triad Chapter by Teresa McCauley, Region 7 Assistant Vice President. The Research Triangle Chapter began the year with 55 members and ended with 48.

The Research Triangle Audit and Control Conference was a huge success due to Conference Chairman Andrew Weniger. Fifty-three audit professionals form the region attended. Richard Roach from the SAS Institute was the dinner speaker during the first night of the Conference, presenting "Trends Away From the Mainframe."

One of the hottest issues of the year was the proposed name change from EDPAA to Information Systems Control Association (ISACA). Because of the strong opposition, the vote on this change was deferred one year. In general, members requested the retention of the name "audit" in the organization name and asked for a vote by the general membership instead of by the small number of attendees at the Annual General Meeting.

At the International meeting, Andrew Weniger represented the Research Triangle Chapter by presenting a check for \$271 which represented 10% of the earnings from the Research Triangle Audit and Control Conference (February 10-11, 1992). The winners of the K. Wayne Snipes Chapter recognition Award were announced at the Awards Luncheon and the Research Triangle Chapter was again a winner.

Andrew Weniger coordinated six pre-meeting technical sessions, all at no charge to the membership along with eight outstanding dinner presentations for the chapter. In September, Ben McLawhorn represented the Chapter at the Region 7 President's Council Meeting in the Research Triangle.

The first annual Carolinas Audit and Control Conference was held on March 1-3, 1993. This was a first for a joint venture between the Research Triangle, Charlotte, Piedmont Triad, and Greenville (SC) Chapters. The three-day multi-track conference was held in Greensboro, NC and was well attended by participants from six states. To coincide with the Conference, the Governors of NC and SC issue proclamations declaring the week of February 28-March 6 as "Information Systems Auditing Awareness Week." The Conference was very successful for all Chapters involved! Total net profit for the conference was approximately \$10,860.

The International Office suggested that individual Chapters incorporate to ensure that general liability concerns were addressed. Therefore, on May 1, 1002, Rufus L. Edmisten, Secretary of the State of North Carolina proclaimed the incorporation of the EDP Auditors Association, Inc. – Research Triangle Chapter.

The appointed International Committee, Image 2000, proposed that the EDP Auditors Association change its name to the Information Systems Audit and Control Association. By virtue of past discussions and input, the word "audit" was retained in the proposed name change. This name was adopted by the membership in July.

At the International Conference in Minneapolis, Minnesota, Teresa McCauley, Region 7 Vice President, represented the Research Triangle Chapter by presenting a check for \$350 which represented 10% of the Chapter's profit from the Carolinas Audit and Control Conference (March 1-3, 1993).

Ben Comer coordinated six pre-meeting technical sessions, all at no charge to the membership along with eight outstanding dinner presentations for the chapter. Tim Phillips led the membership drive. The chapter membership grew to a count of 70 members a the end of the chapter year.

The second annual Carolinas Audit and Control Conference was held on February 28-March 2, 1994. This was a joint venture between the Research Triangle, Charlotte, and Piedmont Triad Chapters. The three-day multi-track conference was held in Charlotte, NC and was well attended by participants from seven states. Total net profit for the conference was approximately \$12,000.

The Board of Directors voted to donate 10% of the Research Triangle proceeds (\$350) to the EDP Auditors Foundation (earmarked for research). Teresa McCauley, Region 7 Vice President presented the check at the Awards Luncheon in London, U.K.

In June 1994, the EDP Auditor's Association, Inc. changed its name to the Information Systems Audit and Control Association. In compliance, the Research Triangle Chapter also changed its name to the Research Triangle Chapter of the Information Systems Audit and Control Association. Also, in June the Officers and Board of Directors met to discuss plans for the coming year. Memberships had lapsed over the spring and summer such that the Chapter began the year with 59 members. Since the Chapter's treasury was in very good standing, the Officers and Directors decided to invest some of the treasury into the membership by bringing in very high quality speakers for the chapter year in hopes of increasing chapter membership. In addition to the high quality programs coordinated by Judy Baker, the Chapter undertook an aggressive membership drive targeting non-member attendees of chapter events. Using direct mail follow-up, headed by Michael Dearing, and special membership offers, the chapter was able to increase membership by 40% to 83 members by the planning meeting for the next chapter year (1995-1996).

Meetings continued to be held at the Raleigh Country Club on the first Wednesday of each month with the exceptions of December (no meeting), January (held on the second Wednesday), and March (no meeting due to the Carolinas Audit and Control Conference). Meetings featured excellent meals and hospitality served by the Raleigh Country Club. Chapter membership dues remained \$25. Judy Baker coordinated all technical seminars and evening sessions; Lisa Staling distributed the newsletter and advertising fliers., and John Carlson published the chapter Directory.

In June 1994, Teresa McCauley represented Region 7at the International Conference, Annual General Meeting, and Leadership Conference in London England. Teresa presented a check for \$350 from the Research Triangle Chapter to the Information Systems Audit and Control Association for the CobiT and UNIX research projects. In August 1994, Terry Young represented the Chapter, and Teresa McCauley represented Region 7 at the President's Council Meeting along with leaders from regions 2, 3 and 4. Also, Teresa McCauley represented the Chapter at the Region 7 President's Council meeting in February 1995.

The Chapter hosted the third annual Carolinas Audit and Control Conference at the North Raleigh Hilton in Raleigh, NC, along with the Charlotte and Piedmont Triad Chapters. This was a three-day three track conference and was attended by 75 attendees and 19 speakers. Net profits were about \$10,400 with about \$4,000 going to the Research Triangle Chapter. As is our custom, the Chapter donated 10% of the net profits, \$400, to the Information Systems Audit and Control Foundation to help fund the CobiT and UNIX projects.

Chapter members were provided with a strong slate of programs in education during the 1995-1996 chapter year thanks mainly to the programming efforts of Bill Hampton. Each chapter meeting was preceded by a technical session with a relevant topic. Topics included Securing and Auditing Unix, Computer Fraud, Client Server Audit and Security, MVS Security and Exposures, Communication Network Security and more. The chapter concluded the year with a joint meeting hosted by the local IIA chapter. In addition, the chapter participated in the fourth annual Carolinas Audit and Control Conference in Greensboro joining the Charlotte Chapter and the host Piedmont Triad Chapter. This three-day conference attracted 53 attendees and speakers from around the country.
